- Original Ford 289 Interceptor V8 engine –Mallory electronic ignition & Edelbrock 4 bbl carburetor installed. (The original Interceptor 1968 Owner's Manual is included.)
- Original varnish on interior of planking, on ceilings & related surfaces cleaned & buffed.
- All bright work cleaned & buffed to 9,000 grit
- Original splash rails still in their original varnish.
- Bilge cleaned & painted with multiple coats of Lyman Tan bilge paint.
- All hardware either plated or polished to show standards.
- Original upholstery & bimini is in as-new condition. New Nautolex in "natural" was installed.
- Topsides sanded, faired & finished with 4 coats of Interlux Epoxy Primekote, followed by 6 coats of Interlux two-part epoxy topcoat. – Snow White topsides & Rochelle Red boot stripe.
- The original solid mahogany bottom planks were sanded, faired, primed & painted.
- All electronics tested for good running.
